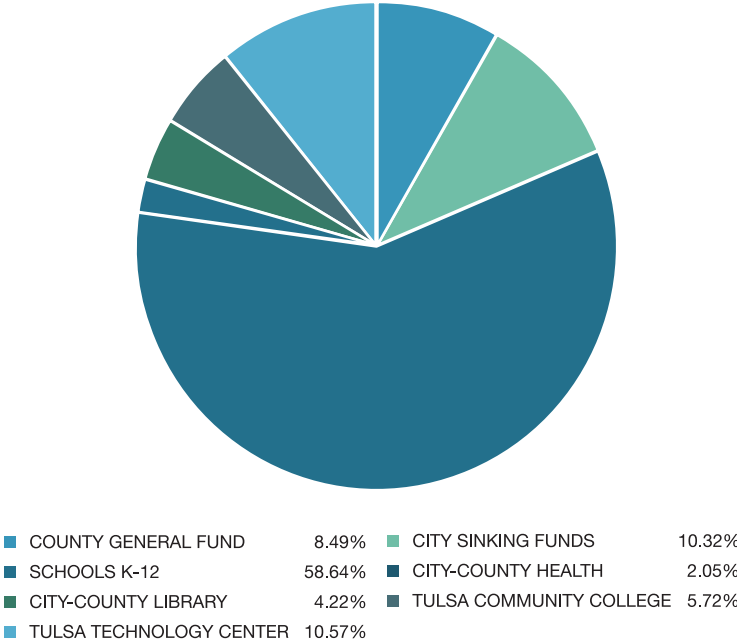

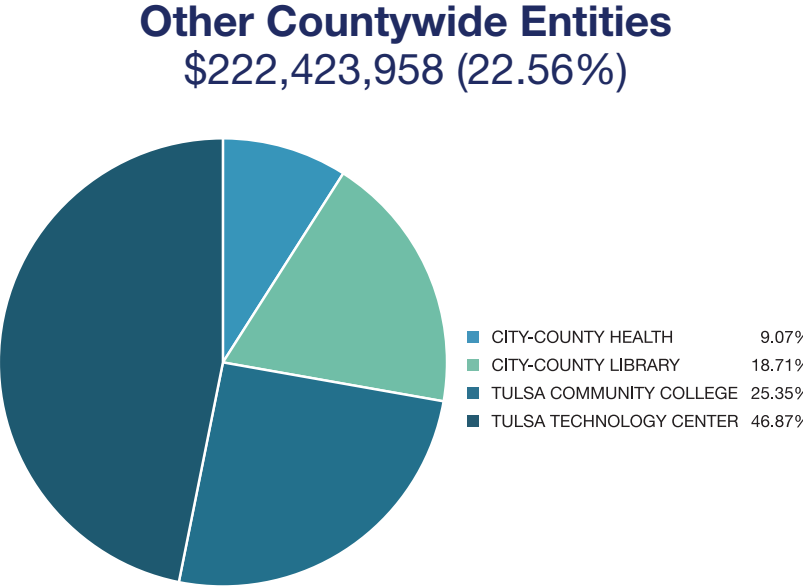
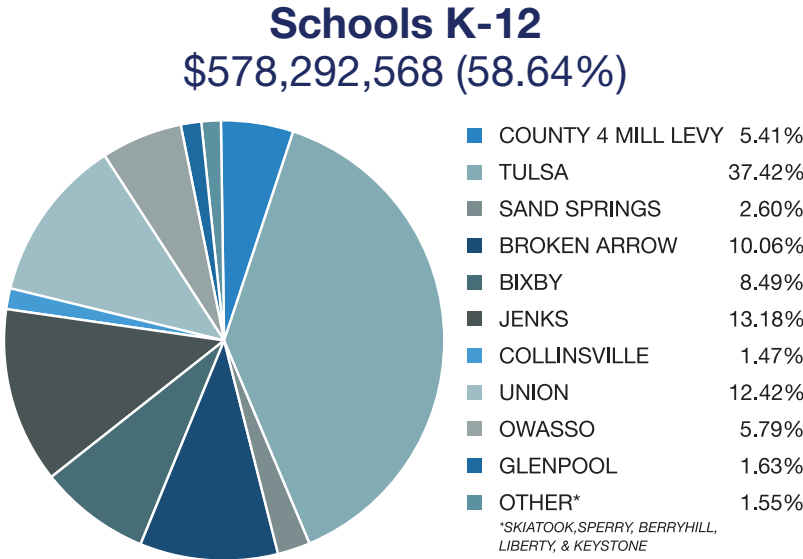
Several forms of taxation are used to generate revenue for governmental and educational purposes. One of the most familiar to taxpayers is the ad valorem tax on property. In Tulsa County, ad valorem taxes generated more than 986 million dollars in Fiscal Year 2023.

The phrase “ad valorem” is Latin for “according to value.” The responsibility for establishing property values for tax purposes is that of the County Assessor. Property taxes are levied per law, by legal rulings, and by approval of voters. Tax amounts are computed in terms of “mills” or denoted as \$1.00 in taxes for each \$1,000.00 in assessed property value. The number of mills levied against a piece of property is approved by the Excise Board as applicable to the political subdivision in which the property is located. Thus, a tax roll is created for collection by the Tulsa County Treasurer.

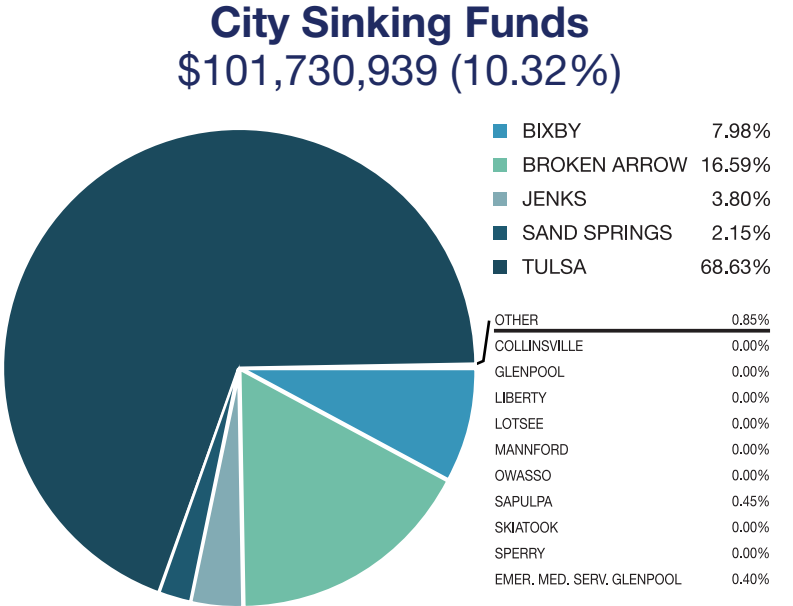
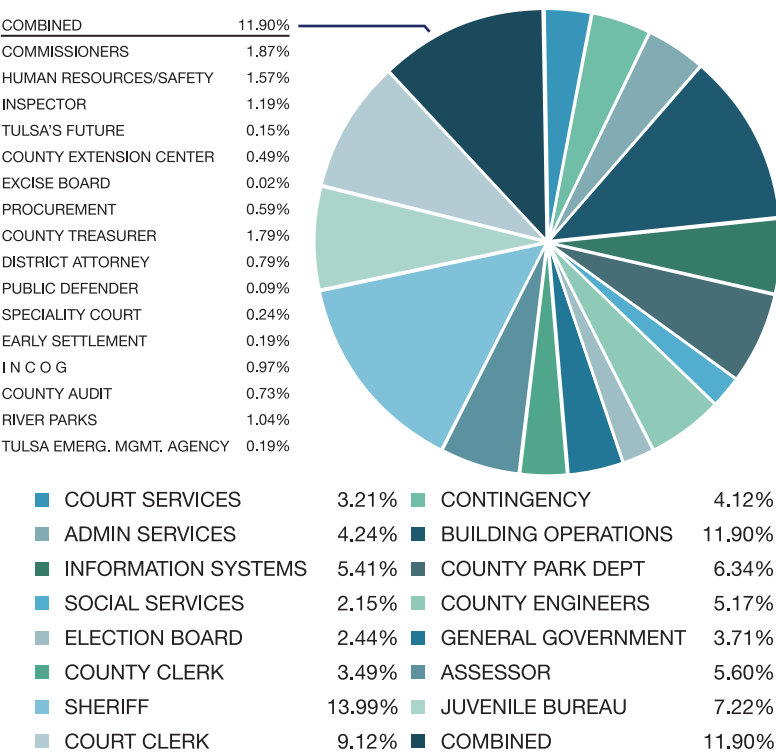
The fiscal year for ad valorem tax-supported entities is the twelve months from July 1 through June 30.

AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES



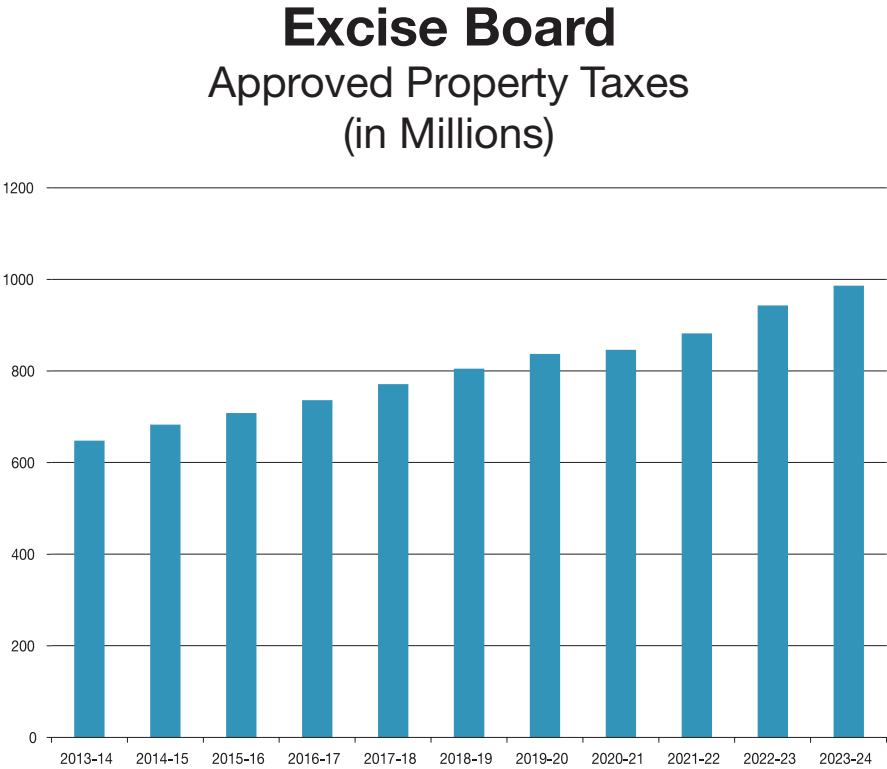

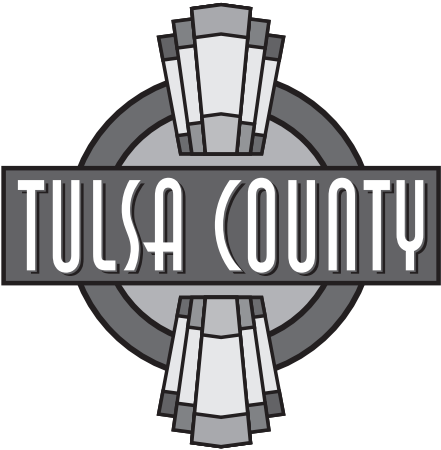
